It may include values, traditions, culture and artifacts.

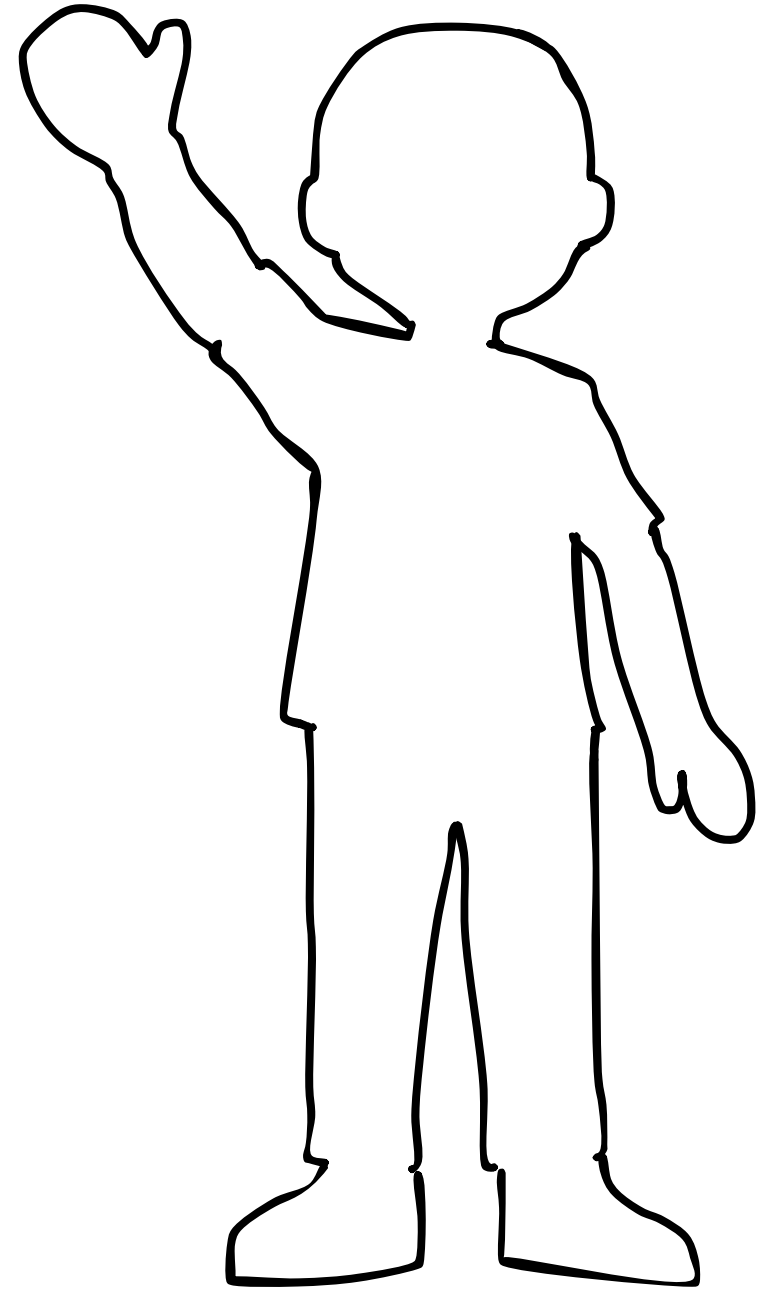
Please fold on the dotted line, put your name on the front,
